
PURPOSE


- Develop a forward-looking, implementable plan that reflects public desires, establishes a compelling vision and guides CRPD for the next 10+ years

- Conduct a comprehensive **Needs Assessment** that accurately reflects CRPD's growing & increasingly diverse population and evaluates the 2014 approved Level of Service (LOS)
- Evaluate and prioritize implementation of **proposed facilities and opportunity sites**
- Realistically address capital and maintenance funding available in CRPD's different district areas
- Craft recommended actions to achieve synchronization with Land Authority Policies, California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) requirements, and Climate Action Mandates.








CRPD AGING POPULATION








