

BOARD OF DIRECTORS ELECTIONS FAQS

Q: Are Board members elected or appointed?

As of November 2022, Board members are elected by-district, in furtherance of the purposes of the CA Voting Rights Act (CVRA). There are 5 voting districts; candidates must reside within the district they are running for and only the residents of that district may elect them (voting districts). Each Board member is accountable to the entire Cordova Recreation and Park District. Mid-term vacancies can be appointed by the remaining Board members or filled in a Special Election.

Q: What are the requirements to serve as a Board member?

A candidate must be a voter within the Cordova Recreation and Park District (<u>Public Resources Code</u> <u>5784</u>) and reside within the voting district they are running for. Board members must complete Ethics training certification every 2 years. Board members must submit an annual Form-700 (Statement of Economic Interests).

Q: How does someone run for a Board position?

The District contracts with Sacramento County to fulfill all of its <u>Board election functions</u>. For more information download the <u>November 8, 2022, Candidate Guide</u>. All paperwork and associated fees are submitted to Sacramento County at: Voter Registration and Elections - 7000 65th Street, Suite A, Sacramento, CA 95823-2315. No paperwork is filed at CRPD.

Q: When can a candidate file paperwork?

Typically, mid-July through mid-August of the Election Year.

Q: How many seats are up for election?

Elections are held on even-numbered years. Terms are staggered (for example: 3 seats are up in 2022 and 2 seats are scheduled to be up in 2024.)

Q: How long is a Board member's term?

Elected terms are 4 years, with no term limits. Appointed terms vary.

Q: Are Board members compensated?

Board members receive \$100 per meeting, up to 6 meetings per month (<u>Public Resources Code</u> <u>5784.15</u>). Board members do not receive health coverage.

Q: What is the typical time commitment for a Board member?

The District currently has 1 Regular Board meeting and several special/committee meetings per month. Meetings are primarily held in the evenings. Reading material for meetings and correspondence to the Board is extensive.
