Lifeguard Training with AED/O2/Title 22 First Aid Ages: 15+

This American Red Cross course is a combination of Lifeguard Training, CPR for the Professional Rescuer, Administering Emergency Oxygen and First Aid for Public Safety Personnel (Title 22). This complete course provides all certifications necessary to obtain employment as a lifeguard in the State of California.

Prerequisites: The required swimming skills include 300 yards continuously swimming (12 laps), tread water for 2 minutes without hands and perform a 20-yard swim with a 10 lb. brick after retrieving it in 7 feet of water. Must be 15 years old by the last day of class.

*Classes require 7 hours of online course work before the first day of class. One week before the class you will be emailed the pre-course login information.

STEP 1 > CHOOSE LEVEL

Grown Up & Me Group Lessons

Shrimps: (Ages 6 mo - 3 yrs)

Beginning lessons for infants and toddlers. Emphasis on water adjustment, floating, bubbles, going underwater, holding breath, kicking and arm movement through songs and games. Requires adult participation in the water.

Seahorses: (Ages 3 - 5 yrs)

Swim readiness class for young children. Introduces floating, bubbles, going underwater, holding breath, kicking, arm strokes, glides, body position and entering and exiting water. Requires adult participation in the water.

Group Lessons for Beginners

Tadpoles: Level 1 (Ages 3 - 5 yrs)

Swim readiness class for young children who are ready to swim with the instructor(s). Introduces floating, bubbles, going underwater, holding breath, kicking, arm strokes, glides, body position and entering and exiting the water.

Guppies: Level 2 (Ages 3 - 5 yrs)

For young children who are able to glide two (2) body lengths, roll over and float for (3) seconds with support. Emphasis on breath control, rhythmic breathing, floating, gliding, sculling, forward propulsion, kicking, arm strokes and basic safety.

Lobsters: Level 1 + 2 (Ages 6 - 14 yrs)

For first-time swimmers. Emphasis on entering and exiting the water, submerging, breath control, rhythmic breathing, floating, gliding, sculling, forward propulsion, kicking, arm strokes and basic safety.

Adult Lessons

Beginner and Advanced Beginner (Ages 15+ yrs)

Lessons will cover basic water skills and introductory swimming. Suited for adults with no swim experience, little swim experience or those who would like to learn fundamental swimming including freestyle and elementary backstroke.

Group Lessons for Intermediate

Turtles: Level 3 (Ages 4 - 14 yrs)

For swimmers who are able to float or tread for 15 seconds and swim five (5) body lengths unsupported. Emphasis on rhythmic and rotary breathing, floating, treading, sculling, forward propulsion and water safety. Introduces freestyle, backstroke and elementary backstroke.

Otters: Level 4 (Ages 5 - 14 yrs)

For swimmers who can swim 15 yards independently. Emphasis on stroke development including freestyle with rotary breathing, backstroke, elementary backstroke and treading. Introduces breaststroke, underwater swimming and reaching rescues.

Dolphins: Level 5 (Ages 5 - 14 yrs)

For swimmers who are able to swim 25 yards of freestyle and 15 yards of backstroke. Emphasis on stroke proficiency and endurance for freestyle, back stroke, elementary backstroke, breaststroke and treading. Introduces sidestroke, diving and survival swimming.

Group Lessons for Advanced

Wahoos: Level 6 (Ages 7 - 14 yrs)

For swimmers who are able to swim 50 yards of freestyle and backstroke and 25 yards of breaststroke, elementary backstroke and sidestroke. Emphasis on stroke refinement and efficiency of freestyle, backstroke, breaststroke and butterfly. Additional skills include starts, turns, surface dives, approach strokes and swimming for fitness.

Private Lessons

Private Lessons: All Levels (Ages 4+ yrs)

Students are able to learn at their own pace in lessons tailored to their skill and learning style based on CRPD's established curriculum.

Hummingbird Park

11990 Cobble Brook Drive, Rancho Cordova

Hummingbird Park is located within the Montelena Development south of Douglas Road. This nature-themed neighborhood park includes a half basketball court, picnic and play areas, and an oval turf gathering space for recreation.




Gold Rush Park

Gold Rush Park is located in the Rio del Oro Development south of White Rock Road. This neighborhood park is centered around a mining theme and includes multiple picnic areas, a gold rush-themed playground, multi-use turf areas, and drought tolerant plantings. **Anticipated opening in early 2024**.



Exploration Park

This park will be located in the Sunridge Village Development south of Douglas Road. The future neighborhood park includes: a 2-5 age play area, a 5-12 age play area, picnic areas, and multi-use turf. The play area in the center will have artistic, space-themed equipment and climbing structures. **Anticipated opening in mid-late 2024**.



Rockrose Park

This 2.12-acre future neighborhood park is in the Arista del Sol Development south of Douglas Road. The park includes picnic areas, meandering walking paths, and landscaping. The design uses drought-tolerant vegetation, cobbles, and boulders to reduce water use and maintenance. **Anticipated opening late 2024**.




Aura Park
