



November 2016

Voters overwhelmingly approved "Measure J," a special tax on property to help support Cordova Recreation and Park District's goal of providing safe, clean and accessible parks and facilities to the community.

July 1, 2017

The special tax assessment appeared on the 2017/2018 property tax bill. The tax rate for single family homes is roughly \$50.00 annually. CRPD received the first assessment in late January 2018.
