### What is the Youth Advisory Committee?

The Youth Advisory Committee is a volunteer group comprised of 9th-12th graders who work with CRPD staff to address youth and teen related issues pertaining to services and safe spaces. Staff will work with the Youth Advisory Committee to develop positive life and decision-making skills, while learning to effect change and cultivate leadership qualities, by connecting with other teens in the community. In addition to volunteering and community service projects, the committee conducts exercises in democratic decision making, assessing and understanding community needs and understanding cultural diversity and team-building projects.

# The CRPD Youth Advisory Committee is looking for 15 qualified applicants to fill its Committee positions for the 2018-2019 term.

### Application Requirements- Incomplete applications will NOT be considered.

Applicants must be high school students who go to school or reside within Cordova Recreation & Park District boundaries. Applicants must be able to attend monthly meetings and events/programs throughout the year.

The CRPD Youth Advisory Committee is empowered by CRPD staff to assume responsibility for certain activities throughout the year. The Youth Advisory Committee is comprised of 15 committee members (YAC members): one (1) elected Chair (President), one (1) elected Vice-Chair, one (1) elected Secretary, one (1) elected Programming Officer, (1) elected Treasurer, one (1) elected Public Relations Officer and nine (9) members at large. Committee members will be assigned/voted into their role once selected for the YAC.

### Youth Advisory Committee Duties

The Youth Advisory Committee members will work together to accomplish these tasks:

- Review issues relating to programs and services for youth
- Provide recreational programs and events to bring families within the community together
- Strengthen community image and sense of place through events and programs
- Create a forum for discussions with youth
- Advocate for services and programs for youth
- Make recommendations for programs, policies and any necessary legislation to promote the health and well-being of youth and their families
- Work with both the public and private sector to bring forth the concerns of youth, as well as evaluate programming that will enhance the development of youth
